

2019 Summer Instructor Positions for Pre-College Tokyo Program

Who We Are:

- [Pre-College Tokyo](#) is a three week summer educational program based in Tokyo, for high school students wishing to get a taste of college life.
- Led by a team of instructors who are each responsible for teaching one or two seminars and also serving as group leaders, resident advisors, and mentors.
- Seminars are project-based and emphasize experiential learning, extensive site visits, field trips, and meetings with local experts and organizations.

Qualifications and Skills:

Japanese Language, Anime & Illustration, Technology & Innovation, Business & Marketing, Fashion Design, Japanese Cuisine & Culture, Photography, Film & Video

- Experience working with or teaching teens
- Proficiency or fluency in local language(s)
- Time spent traveling or living in the destination country
- Strong command of the subject matter you are teaching
- Ability to motivate and engage students in and out of the classroom
- Prior teaching experience is preferred but not required.

Instructors reside alongside our students in a residential hotel and are responsible for not only teaching seminar(s), but also for organizing and participating in afternoon and weekend excursions and other, non-academic activities.

Leaders receive a stipend in addition to having all expenses paid during their program. Leaders are responsible for their own health insurance and are required to be certified in Basic First Aid and CPR at their own expense. Leaders must attend instructor training on their respective program campuses one week prior to the start date of the program. Interviews are held between December and April until all positions have been filled. These are highly competitive positions so please consider applying early.
