Saitama City is an ordinance designated city located just north of Tokyo. The Saitama City Board of Education employs about 5,000 professionals across a variety of education related institutions including 104 elementary schools, 58 junior high schools, 2 special education schools, 4 high schools and one secondary school. These institutions serve the city's 1.3 million residents. Among the city's many educational achievements, Saitama City has long been at the forefront of English as a foreign language education. Starting in 2016, the city has implemented Global Studies, an English curriculum starting with Global Studies as a subject in the first grade of elementary school and extending all the way to the third grade of junior high school. Most recently the city has begun hiring non-Japanese teachers as full-time employees to teach English as a foreign language in its junior or senior high schools. Successful candidates are not hired as ALTs or conversation teachers, rather full-time teachers of their own classes.
