

In 2024, the Shizuoka Prefectural Board of Education will be conducting

native English-speaking high school teacher employment examinations.

The purpose of the exams is:

To recruit teachers who can cultivate students to acquire a high level of English proficiency and can be active participants in a wide range of fields in a global society.

We are seeking:

- Native English speakers with a high level of English proficiency.
- Persons who have a bachelor's degree or higher.
- Persons who have teaching experience of at least 2 years in total at high schools in Japan and have a good understanding of Japanese high school education.
- Persons who are proficient in Japanese and can live their daily lives and work without difficulty.

The outlines of the position are as follows:

- The teachers shall engage in the same work that regular Japanese teachers are expected to do under their principal's direction at public high schools in Shizuoka Prefecture. The responsibilities of teachers are teaching English, club activities, homeroom, and other duties involved with being full-time teachers.
- Working conditions of the teachers are the same as regular Japanese teachers'. If they pass the examination, they will be offered a position as a regular full-time teacher.
- The applicants are not required to have a teacher's certificate. They are not required to be of a certain nationality.

Examination Dates: 【1st stage】 In May, 2024

【2nd stage】 In June, 2024
